With a background in illustration, project management and engineering, I create simple graphical representations of complex systems or processes.

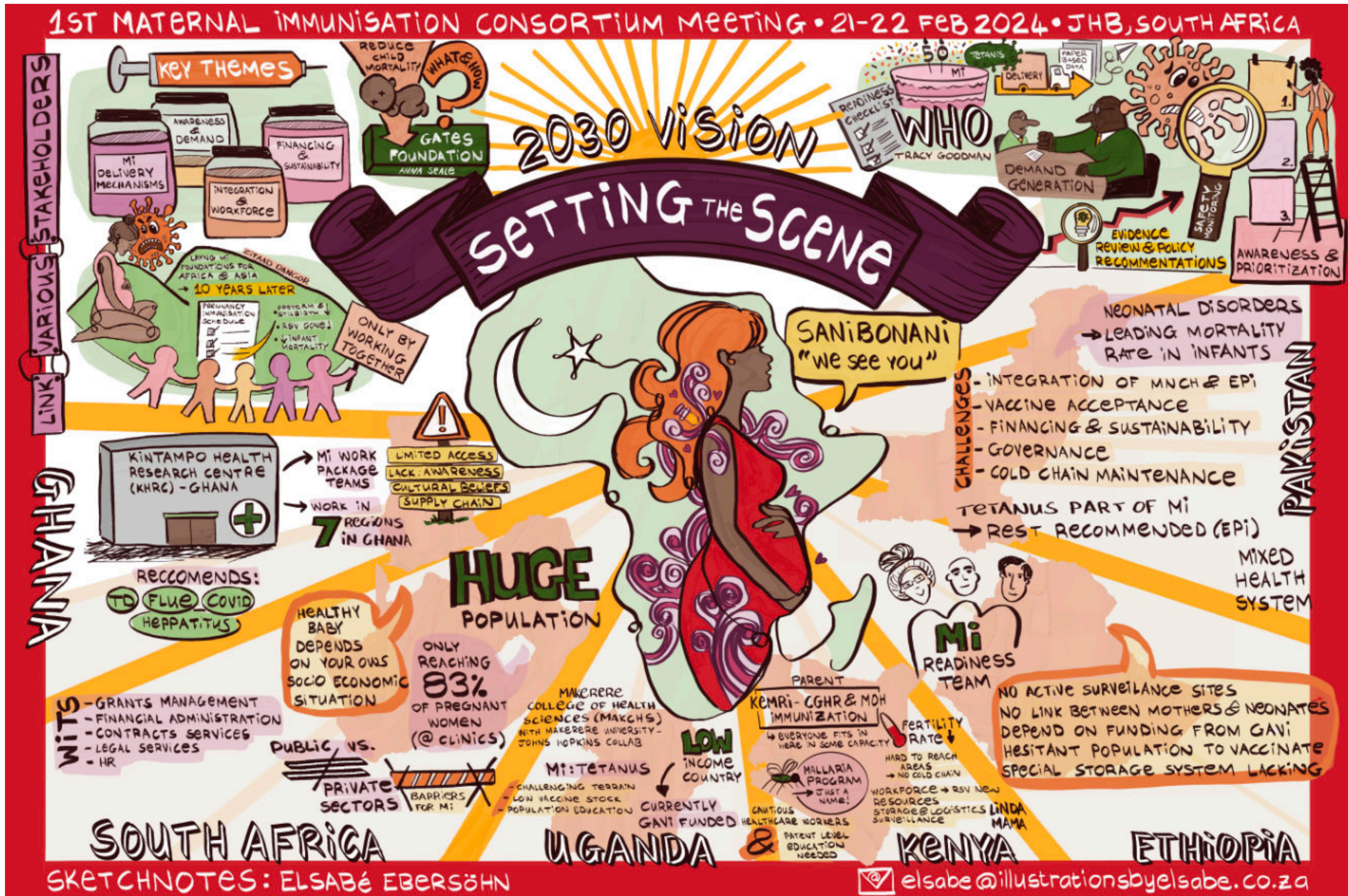

Working on whiteboards, paper or digital while displaying the process on a large screen to delegates. Capture key moments and concepts visually enhances the creative experience of the event taking place.

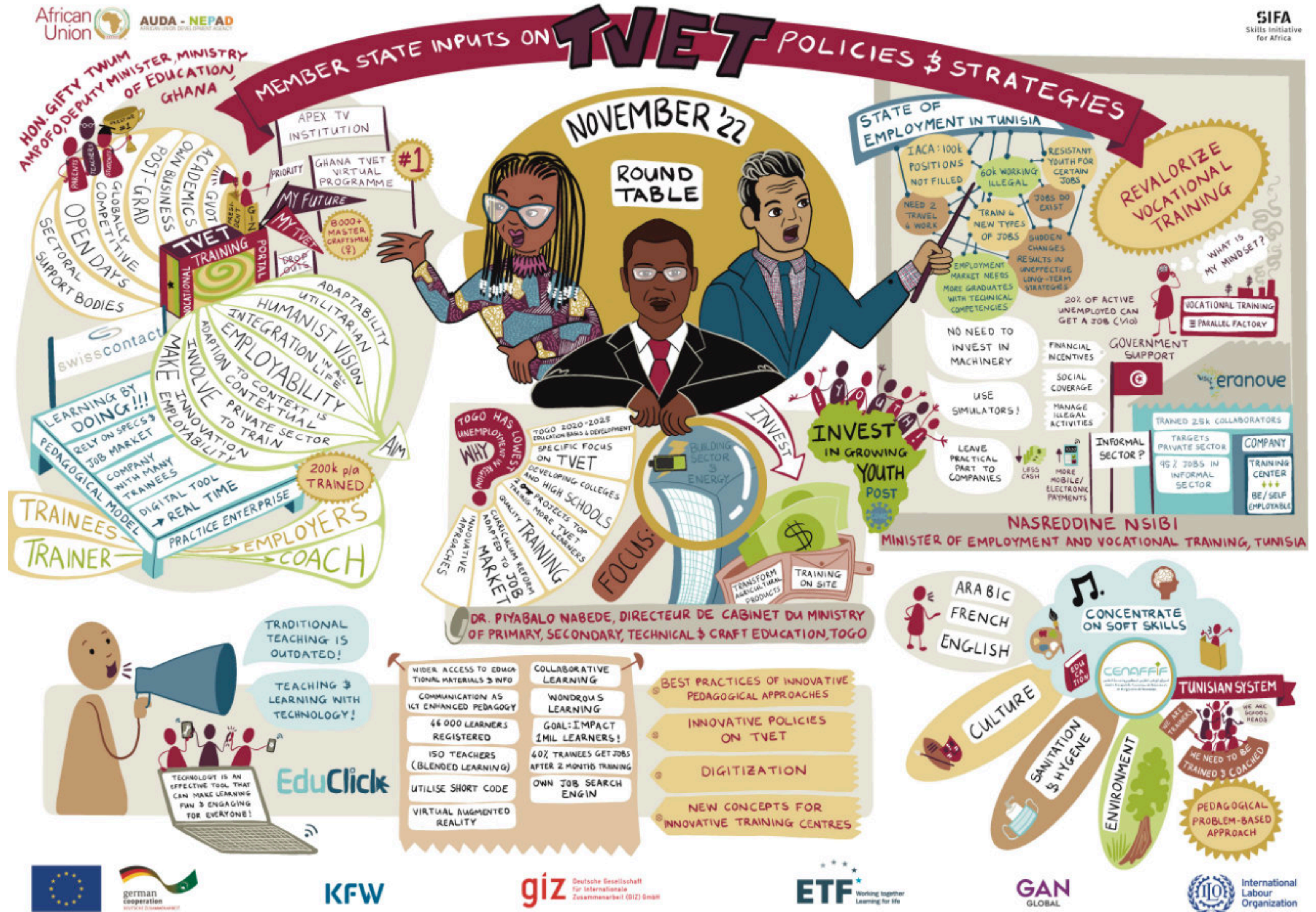




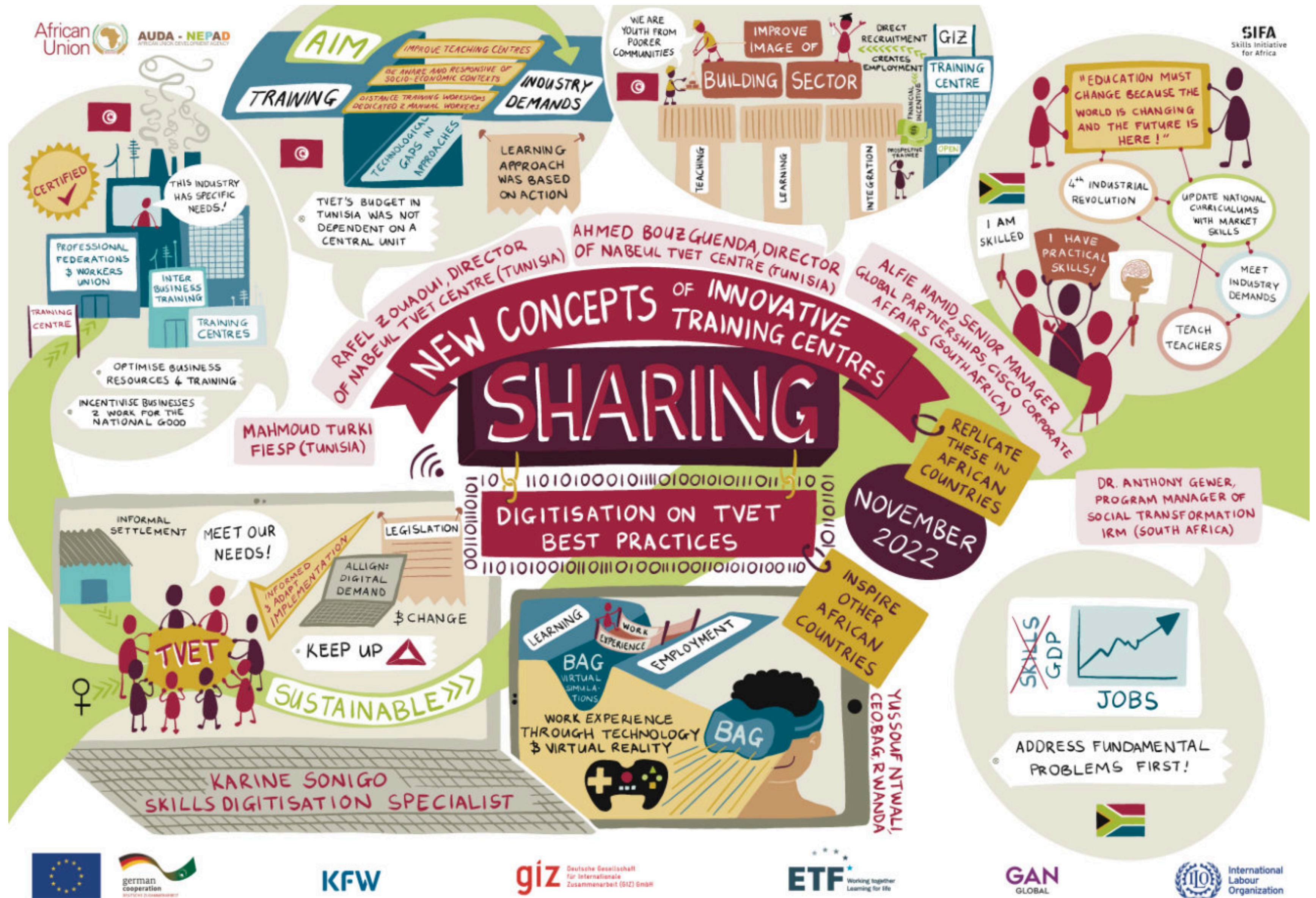
Live graphic harvest: Sketchnotes created digitally, live, in person at event, displayed on large screen while conference session was taking place.



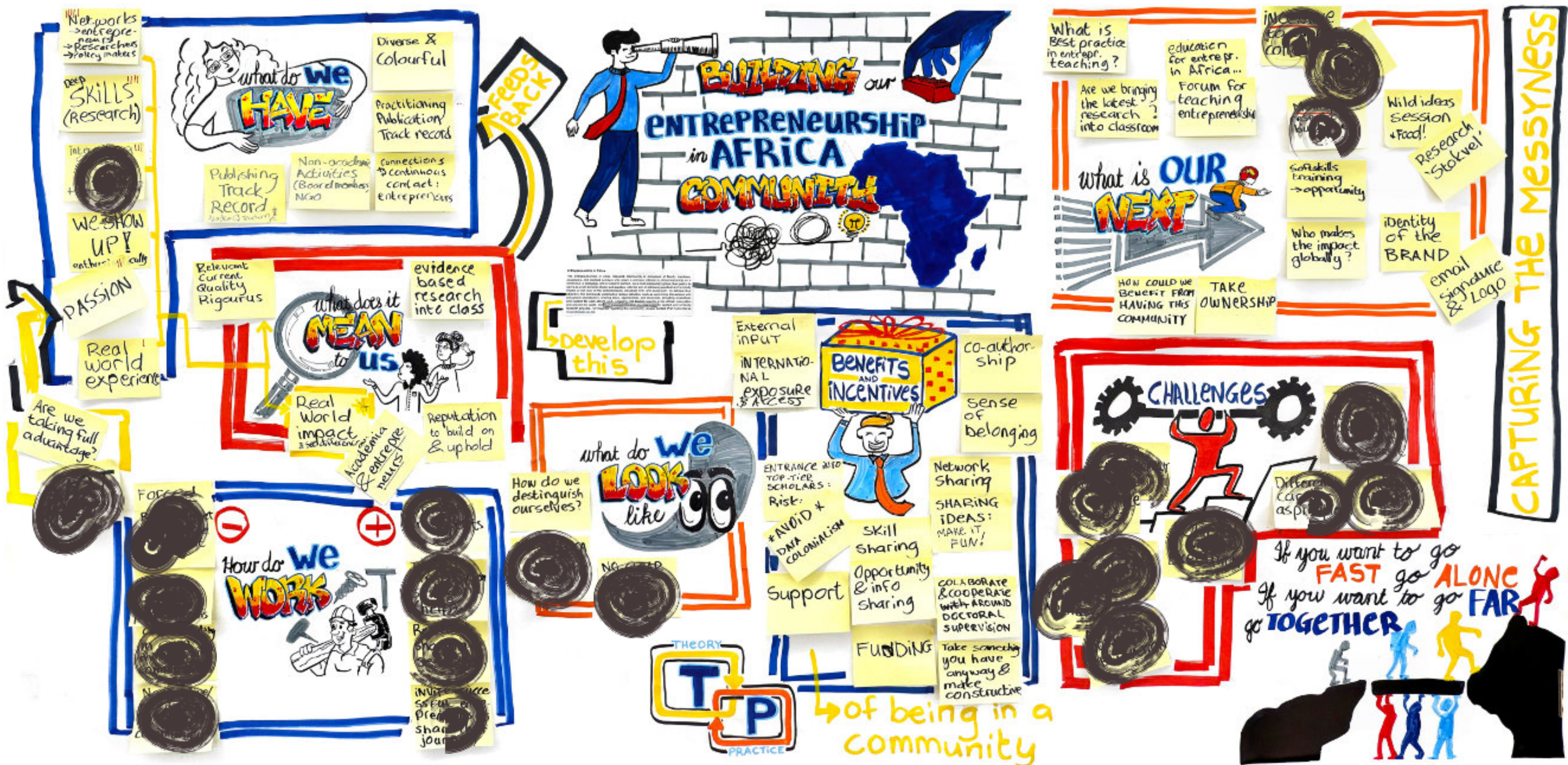
Graphic recording (digitally illustrated) after event took place, using conference recordings as input

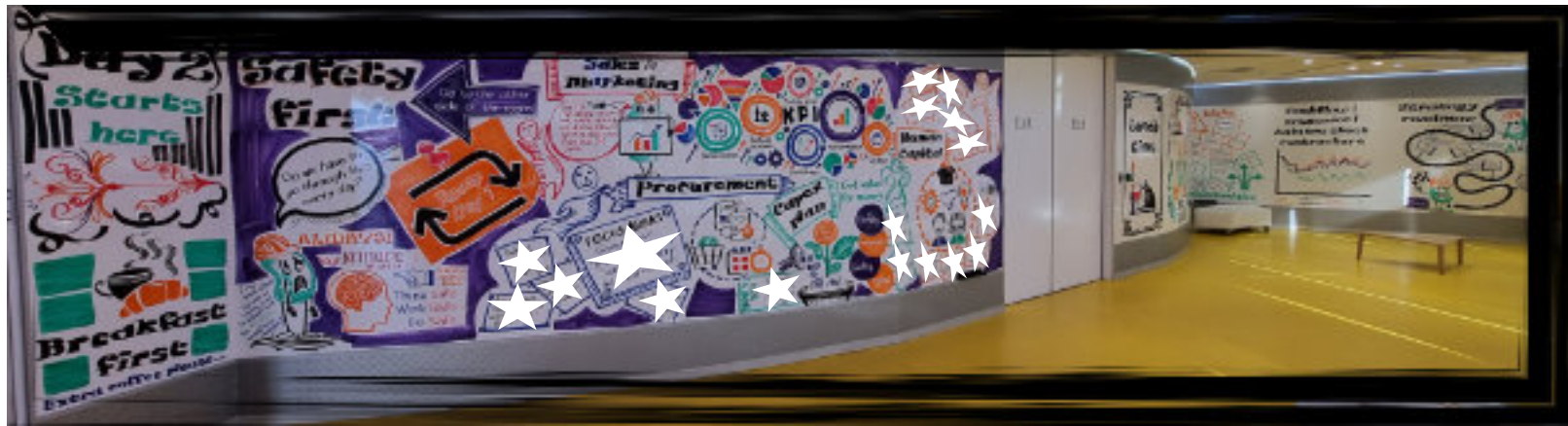
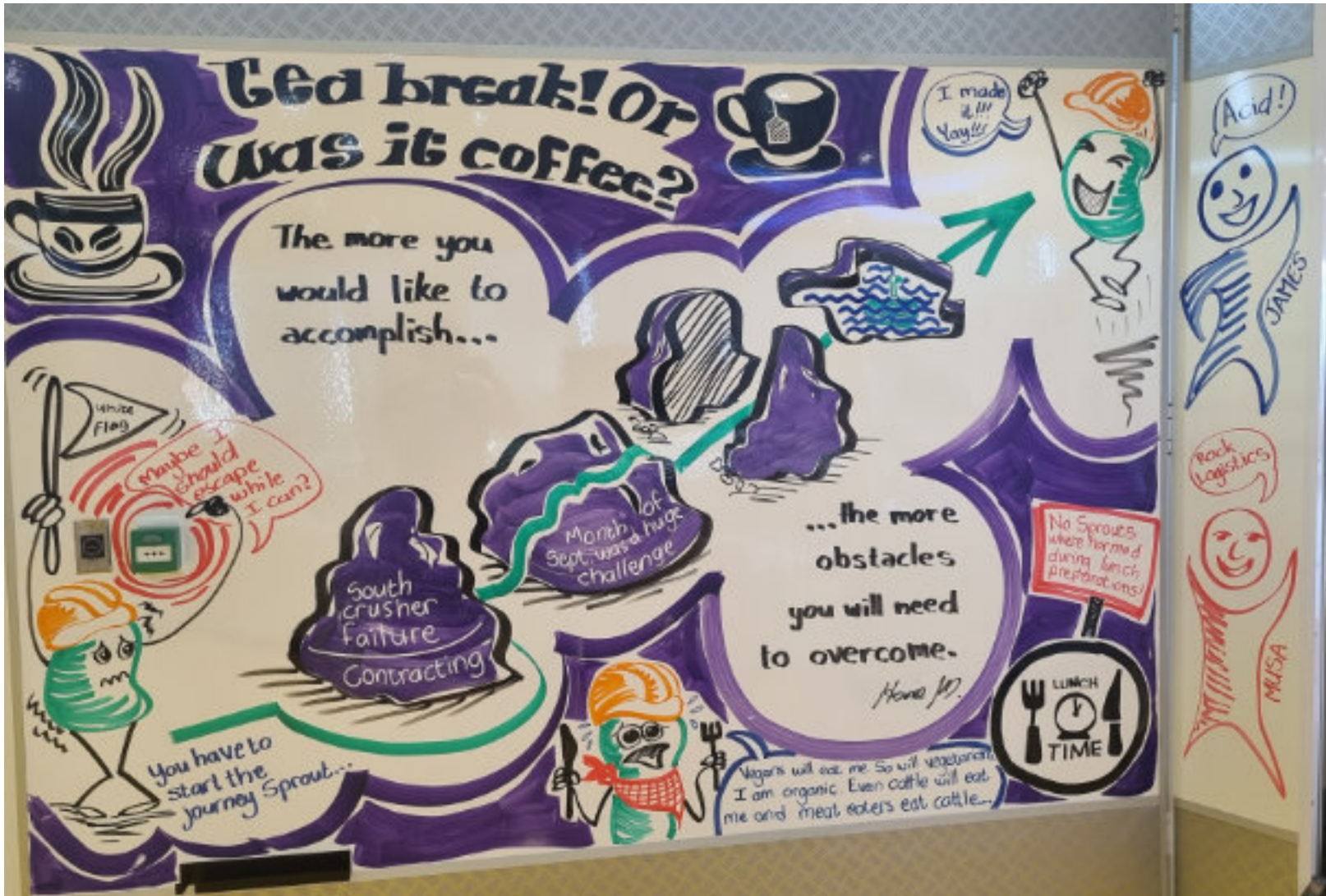
Corporate poster illustrated for client to communicate vision, mission and purpose
